

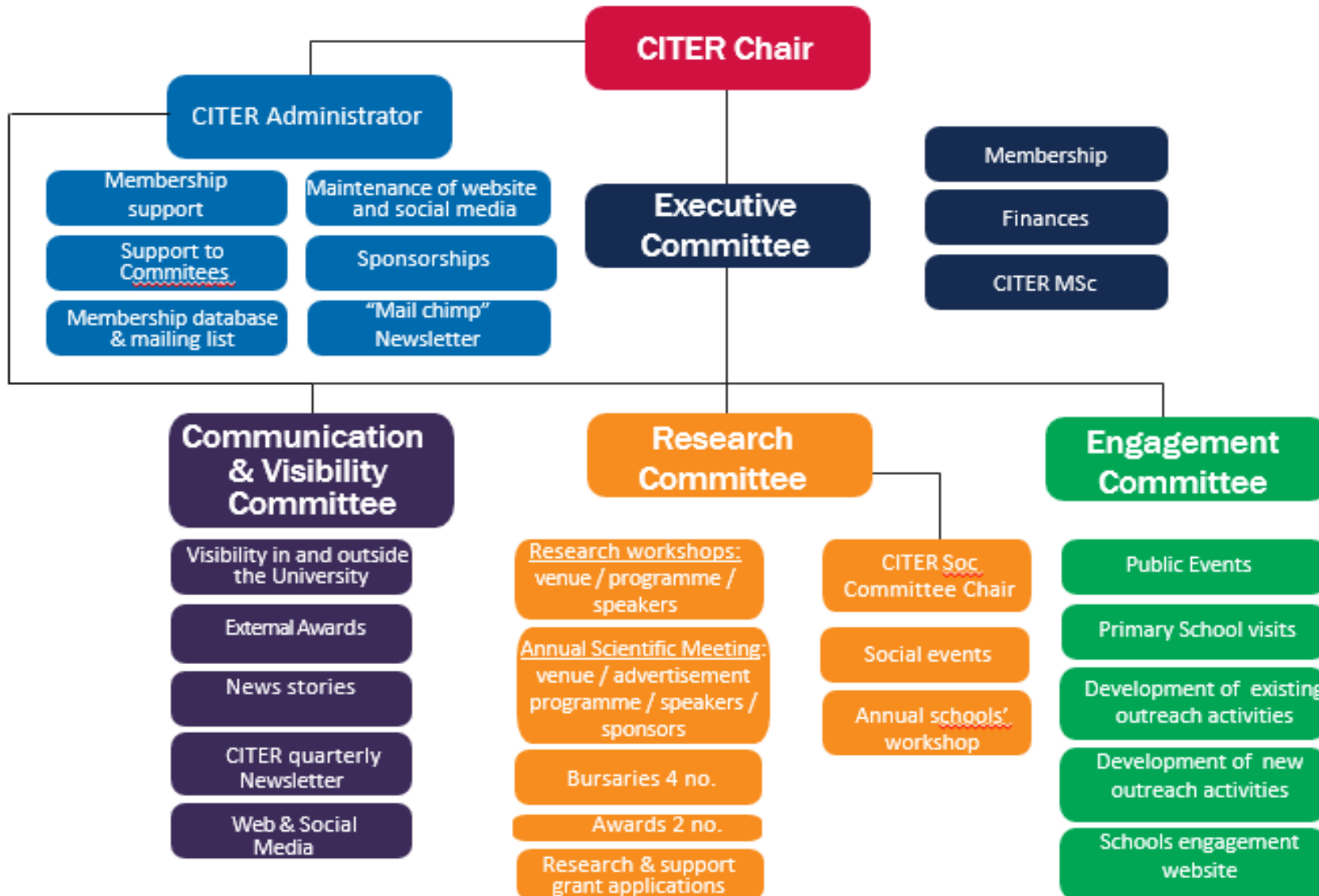


MISSION

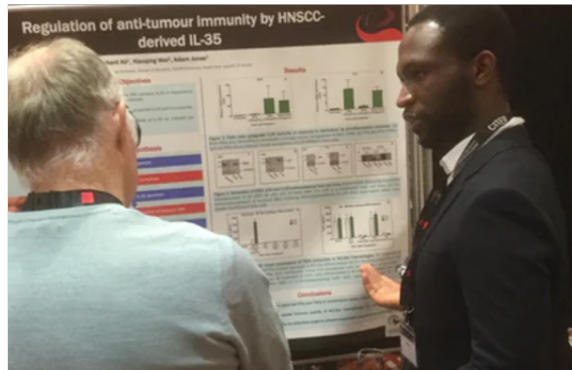
